Objective
The aim of the course is to teach the general principles of attorney law and the regulations regarding the Attorney Law. Within the scope of this course, students are informed about the concept of notification, sources of attorney law, concepts related to attorney law, the nature of the attorney-client relationship and the obligations of the parties arising from this relationship, relevant legislative provisions and problems in practice; It is aimed that students can use this information effectively in practice.

Content
This course centers on the fundamental principles of the legal profession and the regulations of the Attorneys' Act. The content begins with the general principles, sources, and forms of practicing law. The main focus of the course is on the legal nature of the attorney-client relationship. In this context, the attorney's authority (general and special power of attorney), legal fees, and fundamental duties towards the client (duty of loyalty, duty of diligent performance, duty to advise, duty of confidentiality, and duty to return case files) are examined in detail.

The course also covers the attorney's role and importance in legal proceedings, the professional restriction known as the prohibition on advertising, and cases of civil and criminal liability arising from the practice of the profession. The content is taught in light of legislation and case law, aiming for students to gain the competence to apply this theoretical knowledge effectively in practice and to solve professional problems.
